- 9. Exhibit strong interpersonal skills resulting in consistently good interactions
- 10.Promote a positive work environment
- 11. Work as scheduled, including weekends and holidays, according to the Historic Village attendance and scheduling procedures
- 12. Follow Costuming Guidelines for shop.
- 13. Do housekeeping in buildings and surrounding area as appropriate and necessary.
