Tulip or Lancaster Sconce Pattern

The following pattern will produce a Candle Sconce that is 13  $\frac{1}{4}$ " high and 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide at the widest point. The Candle dish is 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

There are detailed drawings of the scroll top and base that can be used to create your master pattern. Check the dimensions after printing them out to make sure your printer has not enlarged or reduced the patterns.

Construction Notes:

The back is soldered to the inside burr of the bottom plate.


The Candle Cup Skirt is formed around the base and the tabs are soldered to the outside of the back.


The base is soldered to the skirt on the inside.


There is no pattern for the candle cup included. Use your favorite.
